Changes to COVID Testing for Essential Caregivers on Tuesday, January 12th

We will be doing the COVID testing for Essential Caregivers a little differently on Tuesday, January 12th. Instead of having to come in to the Manor, we are offering a drive by testing at the front doors of the Manor. This will reduce the amount of times you have to get swabbed (since you will not have to do the rapid test to come in to the Manor). The testing will still be from 10am-noon. See you then!
