

## **Maxville Manor Family and Resident Outbreak Update**

January 4, 2021

If you have not heard, we are now on full isolation across Maxville Manor. That means that residents in every wing are confined to their rooms unless they are wanderers. If they are wanderers, then they will be wearing full Personal Protective Equipment. All common spaces for residents are off limits. We encourage caregiver assistance during mealtimes. Any staff or caregivers entering residents' rooms are required to wear the full Personal Protective Equipment (surgical mask, face shield, gown and gloves). Donning and doffing procedures must be followed when entering/exiting resident rooms. Please watch this video as a reminder how to follow putting on PPE properly.
