

Outbreak Update

The sitter that tested positive with the rapid test has been confirmed as positive with the PCR lab test. This does not change anything for the Manor in terms of Infection, Prevention and Control practices. All staff were tested on Tuesday, January 5 and residents are all being tested today, January 6. We will continue to keep you informed as the situation evolves.

Call for essential caregiver vaccinations

Outside food and drinks

We have been asked if outside food and drink can be provided to staff. However, during the outbreak, we are not accepting any outside food or drinks. Thank you for the kind gestures and we can reassess once the outbreak is over.

Rapid Testing efficient times

As the essential caregiver, it is most efficient to get your rapid test done between 10 am and 6 pm when we have a dedicated nurse able to do the testing. Also, busy times at the Manor are between 12 and 12:30 (lunch time), 2pm (shift change) and 5 to 5:30 (supper time). If you come outside of these busy times, it will minimize your wait time.

Visitation guidelines

Please ensure that you are going only to the resident's room and back to the front door. I have been told that some essential caregivers are doing other things. During the outbreak, it is imperative that you only visit with your loved one.

Sitter restrictions

For the duration of the outbreak, there will be no outside sitters in the Manor.

Reminder: Essential Caregiver Designation – You must choose one

Only one essential caregiver can visit the resident during outbreak. Please email us at info@maxvillemannor.ca to let us know who is the one designated essential caregiver during the outbreak. When visiting, please only visit the resident you are designated for. It is of utmost importance that you screen yourself for COVID symptoms prior to coming to the Manor. If you are unwell, please stay home.
