

I have some unfortunate news to share. I wanted to inform you that we had a positive rapid test this morning. The employee was retested with the rapid and the second test was also positive. A PCR swab has been taken. This likely means that we will find out the result tomorrow and potentially be in outbreak as of tomorrow.

The staff member was working on the B/C unit. As a preventative measure, we are implementing all IPAC precautions on the B/C unit only. This means the following:

- Donning and doffing when entering and exiting the unit
- Isolation carts installed outside of each of the resident rooms
- When possible, residents will remain in their rooms and if the residents are wanderers, then they need to be in full PPE while wandering in the unit
- Dining taking place in the resident rooms
- One-on-one activities with residents

I recognize that this may not be the news that you wanted to hear but we will get through this. We must continue to ensure the safety of the residents and staff at Maxville Manor.
