Hi everyone

As of this morning, we are in suspect COVID outbreak due to a staff member who tested positive twice on rapid test. A PCR was done, and she was immediately sent home. Since the staff member tested negative on December 20, 2021, we are considered day 2 of suspect outbreak.

Based on health unit direction, we have done the following:

- 1) 9 residents for whom she provided direct care in the last 48 hours have been isolated in the FG unit.
- 2) Isolation PPE is outside their rooms in FG Unit including N95 masks.
- 3) These 9 residents will have a PCR done today and again on day 7; if negative on day 7, out of isolation on day 8 or when results are received.

From now on, all essential caregivers and visitors will now be tested as drive through before entering the Manor since we also just had a visitor test positive on rapid test.
